It is my honour to have served as President of the Hong Kong Chinese Medical Association Ltd (HKCMA) over the past 5 years. I am immensely grateful to all patrons, honorary advisors, CME Advisory Board members, as well as past and current council members, who have contributed to the steady growth of HKCMA, which now stands tall as a leading medical organisation providing leadership, fellowship and quality educational and scientific pursuits via conferences and expert group meetings.

I am pleased to present the 2025 Annual Report, covering the period of 1 January 2025 through 31 December 2025.

1. Membership affairs

1.1 The membership fee for July 2024 to June 2025 was waived.

Up to 8 Dec 2025, 79 doctors were added to our Doctor Membership, while 8 nurses, 5 allied health colleagues, 3 medical students, 4 interns and 1 dentist were added to our Associate Membership.

1.2 Medical Indemnity Plan

The service agreement with Lockton has been renewed, featuring a designated Medical Indemnity Insurance Scheme exclusively for HKCMA members.

1.3 Social Activities

HKCMA organised a vibrant day tour to 荔枝窩、吉澳、鴨洲 on 9 Feb 2025, thanks to Dr Ho Chung-ping's leadership. The tour was a resounding success, attracting over 70 participants, which included the President's visitors from overseas, Dr Henry Yeung, Dr Norman Chan, and Dr Christopher Hui. Following the tour, a photography competition was organized by Dr Albert Kong.

On 1 Nov 2025, thanks to Dr Christopher Hui's kind liaison, the HKCMA organised a visit to 和祐醫院 in 佛山, attended by approximately 20 participants.

On 2 Nov 2025, HKCMA provided its members with a unique opportunity to enjoy a private screening of the film "The Volunteers: To the War's End" (志願軍).

2. 2025 Annual events organised by HKCMA

2.1 2025 Career Talk (14 June 2025), kindly organised by Dr SK Ng

HKCMA conducted a Career Talk for 2025 Medical Graduates of CUHK and HKU and Licentiate Graduates at the Hospital Authority Head Office Building (HAHO) on 14 June 2025. Two identical sessions were held that day. An impressive panel of speakers was invited to share their professional journeys, including:

The event provided an opportunity for the medical graduates to network, share experience, and gain a deeper understanding of their future career paths in medicine. More than 40 medical graduates from CUHK and HKU attended the two sessions.

2.2 2025 Annual Scientific Meeting (14 Sept 2025)

The HKCMA held its Annual Scientific Meeting (ASM) at the Cordis Hong Kong with the theme of ***“Management of Chronic Diseases: Bridging Primary and Specialist Care”*** in a hybrid format. Under the leadership of Dr Christopher Hui, Dr Mike Yat-wah Kwan and Dr Kacey Hau, co-chairs of the Organising Committee, the ASM was a great success and attracted a over 344 participants, with 229 attending in person and 155 online. HKCMA was very privileged to have Dr Cecilia Fan, Under Secretary for Health to officiate the Opening Ceremony.

- (a) The Chinese Academy of Engineering Academician Distinguished Lecture on “Advances in the Treatment of Hematological Malignancies: Contributions from China” delivered by Prof Huang Xiajun (黃曉軍院士) from Beijing;
- (b) “Recent Development in PET Technology: Role in Guiding Therapy” (online lecture) delivered by Prof Georges EL Fakhri from USA;
- (c) “From Bench to Bedside: Translational Discoveries in Severe Asthma from CBIOPRED” delivered by 張清玲教授 from Guangzhou;
- (d) “Multi-omics in COPD: Exploration and Challenges” delivered by 陳榮昌教授 from Guangzhou.
- (e) “AI in Surgery” delivered by Prof Philip Chiu;
- (f) “The IMACE and the Ethico-legal Status of Clinical Practice Guidelines” delivered by Prof Gilberto Leung
- (g) “How AI is Augmenting the Doctor-patient Relationship” delivered by Dr Alex Ng of Tencent Healthcare

We extend our sincere gratitude to our Honourable guests, co-chairs, speakers and chairpersons for their contributions to making the event a success. 2.3 2025 中國醫師節香港慶祝大會 (11 Aug 2025)

Jointly organised by HKCMA, the Department of Health, Hospital Authority, HK Academy of Medicine, HKUMed and CUHK Faculty of Medicine, and 香港註冊中醫學會, the 2025 中國醫師節香港慶祝大會 with the theme of 向醫者致敬: 杏林春暖、惠澤社群、感恩有您! was held at the Concert Hall, Hong Kong City Hall, and attracted over 900 attendees.

The event took place on a Monday evening and featured a variety of musical performances by healthcare professionals, as well as heart-warming chit-chat sharing by Profs Rosie Young and Fok Tai-fai, Drs York Chow, David Fang, and Thomas Tsang, and 2 HA Young Achiever doctors. The HA Chinese Orchestra, PYNEH choir, HKU Department of Medicine Singing Group, HKAM band, St John Band, Medipella, Dr York Chow, Dr David Fang, Dr Thomas Tsang and Prof Sydney Tang all contributed to the colourful musical performance.

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3 Publication: the HKCMA e-Bulletin

To strengthen the connection between healthcare professionals and HKCMA, we published the inaugural edition of our newsletter, Bulletin Issue 01 in Oct 2024 highlighting the celebration of 2024 中國醫師節 in Hong Kong. Approximately 9,000 printed hard copies were distributed through our publisher's (Vital Base) network. Additional hard copies were made available for collection at the HKU and CUHK student lounges, allowing easy access for students and faculty.

Following the successful launch of Issue 01, e-Bulletin Issues 02, 03, 04, and 05 were published in January, April, September, and October 2025, each issue aiming to provide timely updates, to feature notable healthcare topics, and to highlight HKCMA's ongoing initiatives and achievements. 5.3 Hong Kong Obesity Alliance

香港關注肥胖症聯盟跨專科成立香港關注肥胖症聯盟、冀社會大眾與政府正視肥胖並抓緊政策良機發佈會 was held on 27 August 2025. The formation of the Hong Kong Obesity Alliance (HKOA) of 3 medical organisations: the HK Chinese Medical Association, the HK Obesity Society and the HK Society of Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery was announced on 27 August 2025. The definition and complications of obesity was presented, and the HKOA's survey of 500 HK residents showed misconceived notions about obesity which required community education.



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On 21 September 2025, Hon Dr Dennis CS Lam organised a Fun Fair called 共迎全運『燃脂有物』控體重－防慢病健康嘉年華 at Tseung Kwan O shopping mall, where residents were offered to have their BMI measured and their urine screened for albumin.

5.4 RSV Immunization Campaign 2025

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The RSV Immunization Campaign is dedicated to driving RSV disease awareness and emphasizing the urgency and importance of prevention and management of RSV diseases among both medical professionals and the public.

Supported by a joint statement from leading medical societies as well as HKCMA in Hong Kong, titled “Caring for Infants and Vulnerable Individuals with Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) at Home and Their Prevention” issued in April 2025, the campaign advances comprehensive education on RSV and its immunization recommendations for populations ranging from infants to older adults.

HKCMA also organized an RSV Immunization Campaign Press Conference to announce key health messages and updated vaccination information to the media, engaging them to convey these to the public on 23 November 2025. The invited speakers of the press conference are:
